President's Report 2025

CCFA was founded in 2005 by **Stephanie Brown** and two of her colleagues, who recognized a glaring gap in Canada's animal-advocacy landscape. At the time, people were raising their voices for companion animals, animals used in research, the fur industry, and even circus animals — but **farm animals had no dedicated advocates**.

What they *did* have was determination. There were no funds, no volunteers, no bank account, and not even a mailing address. Yet these three committed individuals laid the foundation for what would become CCFA.

Today, that seed of an idea has grown into a **registered charity** supported by more than **450 annual donors**, countless volunteers, and — at long last — a bank account and a mailing address. Their early vision continues to shape a national movement for farm animal protection.

As part of our **2025–2028 Strategic Plan**, we committed to raising public awareness about the lives of farmed animals. The early feedback was overwhelmingly positive, which fueled our enthusiasm and confirmed we were on the right path. One of CCFA's Directors connected us with a colleague in the advertising world who generously volunteered their expertise. Their guidance shaped our approach to public-facing materials: **short, powerful messages paired with compelling — but not graphic — imagery**.

We continue to advocate at every level — government, industry, and the public — through **petitions, email campaigns, and letter-writing efforts**. The outcomes can sometimes be discouraging, but they are never wasted. Every action, no matter how small, pushes the idea forward. Change rarely arrives all at once; it builds, step by step, until the moment it finally takes hold.

As we look ahead, I'm reminded that meaningful change has always begun with people who refuse to give up — people like you. Every signature, every conversation, every donation, every hour volunteered has helped shift the landscape for farmed animals in Canada. Progress may not always be immediate, but it is unmistakable. Together, we are building momentum that cannot be undone.

Our work is far from finished, but our resolve has never been stronger. With your continued partnership, CCFA will keep pushing boundaries, amplifying the voices of farmed animals, and driving the change they deserve.

Here's to the next chapter — and to the next 20 years of compassion, courage, and impact.

Strategic Plan 2025-2028



CCFA has established a strategic plan for 2025–2028 to ensure our mission is carried out effectively and sustainably. The plan is a realistic one in that the results can be achieved in a three-year timeframe given our financial and personnel resources.

VISION: A world in which farmed animals are treated humanely at all stages of life.

Objective A: Engage Canadians in Improving the Lives of Farmed Animals by raising public awareness of the disparity between best practices for animal agriculture and current practices in Canada and inspire citizens to support change. We will also empower members of the public by providing them with a toolkit that inspires them to take action for positive change.

Objective B: Activate Grassroots Support by enlisting CCFA volunteers, equipping them with localized toolkits, to engage the public in supporting positive change for farmed animals, as well as leverage public support and work with partners to approach legislators and industry players to influence change.

Objective C: Grow Organizational Capacity by increasing recurring donations by explaining the benefits of recurring donations, such as better planning and budgeting as well as lower expenses associated with acquiring new donors. We will establish CCFA volunteers in all regions of Canada who are familiar with the political and legal environment who can be called upon to participate in campaigns as well as maintain effective administration.

Foie Gras Campaign

For foie gras production, 3-month-old ducks (who have only recently learned to quack), are immobilized in individual cages or small group pens. Then, for two weeks, long metal pipes are forced down their throats and more than 1.75 kg of food a day is pumped into their stomachs. Their livers swell up to 10 times their normal size. This not only causes extreme pain and suffering, but some die as a result. At only three months old, the ducks are sent to slaughter.

In 2025, we distributed many foie gras flyers in Calgary, Toronto and Montreal.

We also initiated petition e-6771 to ban foie gras in Canada which garnered 7280 signatures. This petition was also promoted on social media, raising awareness among people who may not already follow animal welfare causes.

Thanks to our foie gras campaign and petitions, in October of 2025 Omni Hotels and Resorts confirmed it will cease offering foie gras over its entire chain.

Awareness Campaign

In 2025 we launched our awareness campaign with posters going up in Montreal and Toronto, including a billboard on Queen Street East in Toronto, and posters in 230 subway cars in Montreal!

This campaign focuses on advocating for animals to be legally recognized as sentient beings, collaborating with provincial and territorial governments to strengthen animal welfare legislation, and raising awareness among the public of the plight of farm animals.



New Animal Sentience Petition

Sentience is the ability to experience feelings and sensations, and is an ethical basis for determining that animals deserve moral consideration

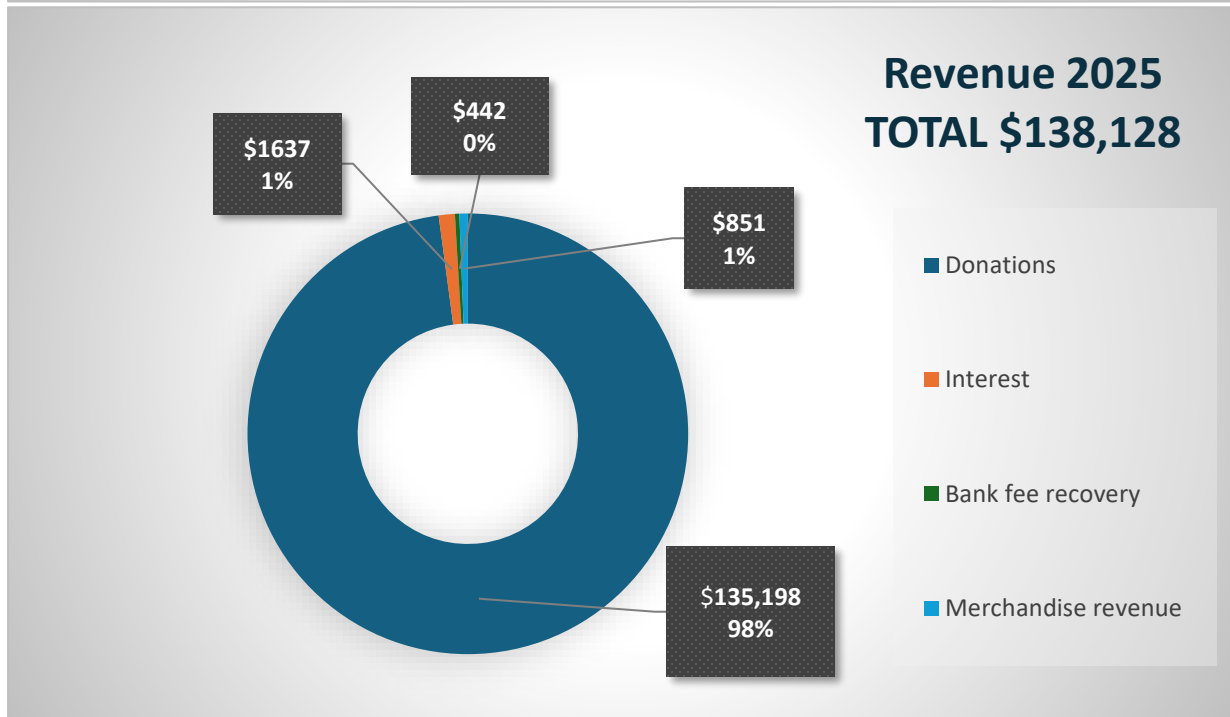
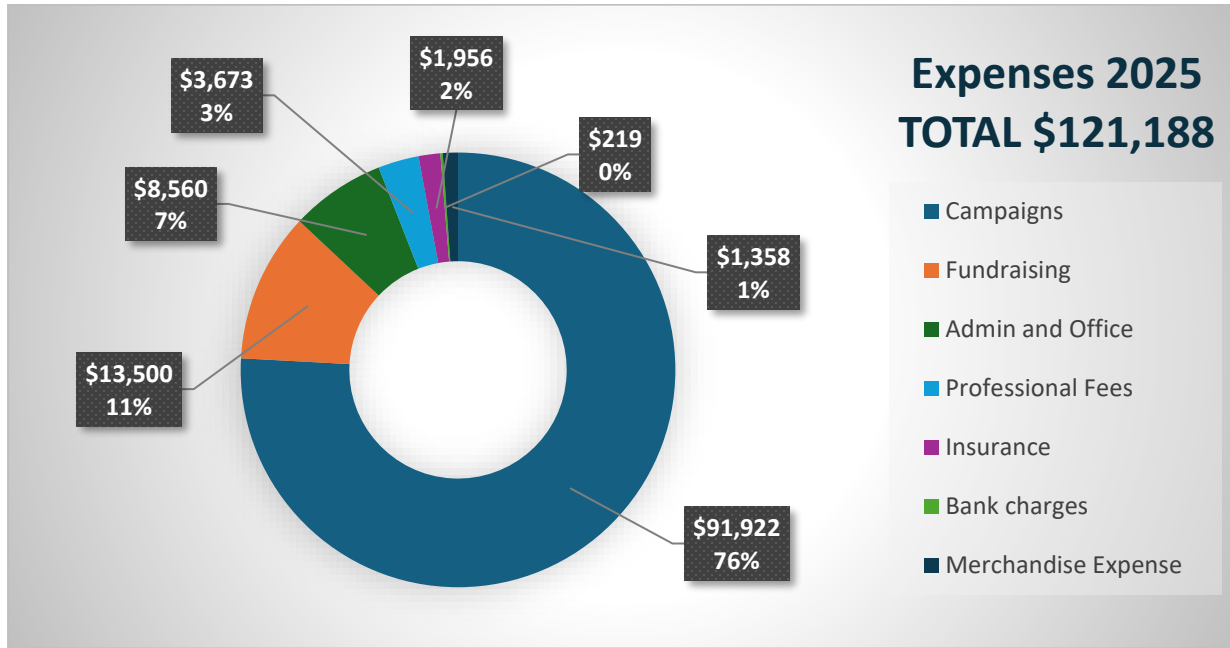
In 2024, CCFA initiated petition e-5114 to call upon the government of Canada to pass legislation that recognizes animals as the sentient beings they are, rather than mere property. The petition garnered 10,187 signatures. However, in January of 2025 the government was prorogued. As such, we needed to re-initiate this petition in 2025.
